In other news, Rock Springs Home School and freedom loving parents still have to oppose the daytime curfew ordinance which would require all citizens under the age of 18 to not be in public places from the hours of 8:00 AM to 2:30 PM. The ordinance passed the second reading February 19th, 2008. The citizens of Rock Springs only have one more chance to prevent this ordinance from being implemented.

We have discovered that at any given day the school has 14% of their population not in school. We also know that the school system has an OPEN campus, meaning that kids are not required to stay on campus for lunch or during an open period.

While researching daytime curfews and truancy issues across the country WyWatch came across a pilot program that would benefit the city of Rock Springs and their school system. <http://www.wywatch.net/PDF/Truancypilotprogram.pdf> This could be offered as a solution to their problem instead of going overboard and restricting an entire population's constitutional freedoms.
